REGISTRATION PROCESS

UTC only **accepts** student entries from the school where they are currently enrolled, with a minimum of 10 participants per subject.

1. The ICAS process begins with schools sending the parent invitation letter to encourage parents to register for the assessment. After receiving registrations and payments from parents, schools submit the 2026 ICAS Entry Form and Student Template to info@icasindonesia.co.id
2. UTC will process the registration is then processed and invoice will be sent to school.
3. Once the ICAS licenses are ready, Janison notifies the school, and any discrepancies between licenses and registration numbers should be reported to UTC immediately
4. Schools are responsible for logging into the ICAS Portal to upload student details and assign the respective ICAS licenses.
5. 2026 ICAS Test Day
6. Release of the ICAS results.
